DEFAULT JUDGMENT

UPON reading the Plaintiff's application for default judgment dated the 9th January 2020

AND UPON being satisfied that the Plaintiff was duly served.

AND the Acknowledgment of Service not having been filed by the Defendant within the required time frame, it is this day adjudged that the Defendant must pay to the Plaintiff **CI\$56,663.49** made up as follows:

1. The principal sum of: CI\$53,130.15
2. Pre-judgment interest at the contractual rate of 14% as follows;
 - a. From 7th February 2019 to 4th November 2019 at 14% per annum: CI\$1,046.49
 - b. From 5th November 2019 to 9th January 2020 at 14% per annum: CI\$1,345.08
3. Fixed Costs made up as follows:
 - a. Legal Fees: CI\$500
 - b. Filing Fee: CI\$200
 - c. *Ad valorem* fee: CI\$441.77

In addition, the Defendant must pay the Plaintiff post-judgment interest from 10th January 2020 at the contractual rate of 14% being \$20.38 per day, until the debt and interest are paid in full.
