
AND UPON reading the Eleventh Affidavit of Roy Bailey and Exhibit thereto dated 4 December 2012 ("Bailey Affidavit")

IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED THAT:

- 1 The remuneration of the JOLs for the period from 1 August 2010 until dissolution of the Company in the amount of US\$722,817 as set out in paragraph 2.1 of the Bailey Affidavit is approved.
- 2 The Company is dissolved and the JOLs discharged as of 13 December 2012.
- 3 The Company's books and records and JOLs' files shall be preserved by the JOLs for at least 6 years and may be destroyed on or after 13 December 2018.
- 4 The JOLs' costs of this Summons be paid out of the assets of the Company, as an expense of the liquidation.
