IT IS ORDERED that all legal fees and expenses reasonably and properly incurred by Mr Leigh Harmer as representative of the Orchid Action Group (including the costs of his summons) in relation to the adjourned sanction application brought by the joint official liquidators pursuant to their Summons dated 21 May 2013, be paid out of the liquidation estate pursuant to CWR O.24, r.9(5), such costs to be taxed on the indemnity basis if not agreed.
