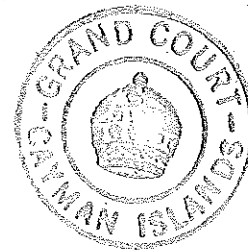

ORDER



UPON HEARING counsel for the official liquidators of Weaving Macro Fixed Income Fund Limited (the "Company") upon their Summons dated 10 October 2014 and counsel for the Liquidation Committee

AND UPON READING the Sixteenth and Seventeenth Affidavits of Ian Stokoe of PWC Corporate Finance & Recovery (Cayman) Limited (together with Exhibit "IS-16") sworn on 10 and 16 October 2014 and the Sixth Affidavit of Hugh Dickson of Grant Thornton Specialist Services (Cayman) Limited (together with Exhibit "HD-6") sworn on 15 October 2014, filed on behalf of Mr. Stokoe and David Walker (referred to as the "**Principal Liquidators**") and on behalf of Mr Dickson and Paul McCann of Grant Thornton (Ireland) LLP (referred to as the "**GT Liquidators**")

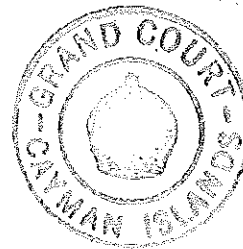

AND UPON the Principal Liquidators and the GT Liquidators having agreed with the Liquidation Committee to discount their hourly charge out rates by 10% for all categories of staff (including the GT Liquidators' forensic team) with effect from 1 October 2014 until 31 December 2015

IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED that:-

1. The remuneration of the Principal Liquidators for the period 1 March 2014 to 31 August 2014 in the sum of US \$228,660.00 is hereby approved.
2. The remuneration of the GT Liquidators for the period 1 March 2014 to 31 August 2014 in the sums of US \$261,660.50 and €199,683.00 is hereby approved.
3. The remuneration of the Forensics department of Grant Thornton Dublin for the periods: (i) 1 September 2010 to 28 February 2014 in the sum of €171,927.00; and, (ii) 1 March 2014 to 31 August 2014 in the sum of €331,643.75, is hereby approved.
4. Both the Principal Liquidators and the GT Liquidators shall, as soon as practicable after receiving the approval of the Liquidation Committee, apply for Court approval of their remuneration for the period 1 September 2014 to 28 February 2015.
5. The hearing of the applications referred to in paragraph 4 above shall take place on Friday 17 April 2015.
6. Both Liquidators' costs of and incidental to this Summons shall be paid from the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
