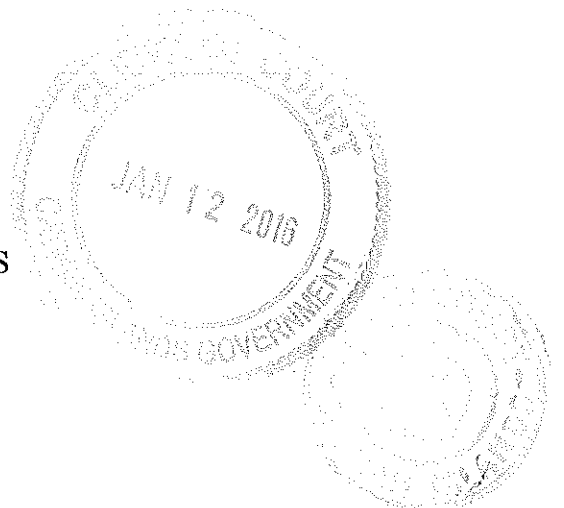

ORIGINATING SUMMONS


LET THE DEFENDANT of 24 Pasture Drive, Bodden Town, Grand Cayman
attend before a Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on
the day of , 2016 at o'clock in the fore/afternoon on the hearing of
an application by the Plaintiffs of George Town, Grand Cayman, who seek the
determination of the Court as follows:-

- i) A declaration that the Defendant is not the sole beneficial owner of that parcel of land known as George Town Central , Block 13D, Parcel 111 together with the rental units thereon.('the Property')
- ii) A declaration that the said Property forms part of the estate of the late Isaac Wellington, deceased.
- iii) A declaration that the Defendant holds the Property on a trust for the estate of the deceased for himself and all the Plaintiffs.
- iv) A declaration that the persons entitled to claim or benefit from the said estate per stirpes are:
 - Delroy A. Wellington
 - Lindell G. Wellington
 - Audrey Wellington
 - Barrington Wellington
 - Sharon Watler
 - Lynval R. Wellington
 - Lorna Beckford
 - Sandra Wellington
- v) A direction/declaration that the Defendant is liable to account for rents and profits of the Property from the date of death of the deceased until presently.
- vi) An Order restraining the Defendant from disposing of the said land without leave of the Court.
- vii) An Order that the Registrar of Lands do register an inhibition over the property to prevent the registration of any dealing with the land pending further order of this Honourable Court or determination of these proceedings.
- viii) An order that the Court do appoint Personal Representatives of the estate of the said Isaac Wellington.
- ix) That the said Personal Representatives do give an administration bond with a surety or sureties for duly collecting, getting in and administering the estate which bond shall be in a penalty of double the sworn value of the estate.
- x) That a copy of the order sought herein be served on the Registrar of Lands upon perfection.
- xi) That costs be borne by the estate.

- xii) That there be liberty to apply.
- xiii) Further and/or other relief as to the Honourable Court shall deem fit in the circumstances.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within (14 days) after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgment of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, Cayman Islands.

Notice for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Originating Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorized to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
