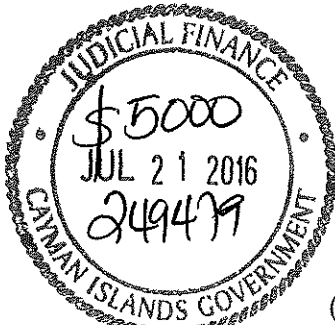

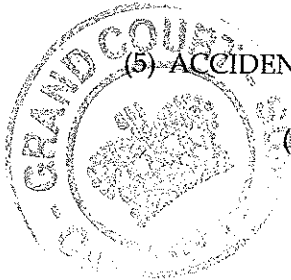


If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS (on behalf of Torchlight Fund LP and on its own individual behalf):

Against each of the Defendants:

1. That it be compensated by way of damages for its causes of action relating to:
  - a. unlawful means conspiracy;
  - b. breach of contract and/or breach of confidence;
  - c. procuring or inducing a breach of contract and/or confidence; and
  - d. unlawful interference.
2. An order for an account of profits made by the Defendants;
3. An order for interest at such a rate and for such time that this Honourable Court think fit;
4. The Plaintiff's costs; and
5. Such further and/or relief as this Honourable Court thinks fit.
