THE PETITION of IDALEYNI VAZQUEZ VEGA SHOWS

1. That on the 27th day of December 2008, at The Beach in the District of West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage the marital status of the parties was as follows –
 - a. The Petitioner Idaleyni Vazquez Vega was a [divorcee] and
 - b. The Respondent Scott Bertram Henderson was a [divorcee]
2. That, following the celebration of the said marriage, the parties have lived and cohabited at the following places –
 - a. #25 Jackdaw Close, Northward, Grand Cayman
 - b. #11 Moon Bay Condos, Pease Bay, Grand Cayman
 - c. #6 Archie Street, Savannah, Grand Cayman
3. That the Court has jurisdiction in the above cause by reason that – The Respondent is Caymanian and the Petitioner has been lawfully and ordinarily a resident in this jurisdiction since at least 2 years preceding this Petition.

4. That since the celebration of the said marriage the parties to the marriage have lived apart for a continuous period of at least two years immediately preceding presentation of the petition and by reason of that fact the marriage has irretrievably broken down.

PARTICULARS of SEPARATION

The Petitioner and the Respondent last lived together in this jurisdiction and as man and wife until about February 2015. The Respondent has since lived separate and apart from the Petitioner.

There has been no resumption of marital relations since February 2015 and no attempts at reconciliation have been made or are intended.

5. That there is no arrangement made in connection with these proceedings that Petitioner desires the Court to take into consideration.
6. That there are no children of the marriage except as follows:
 - a. LUNA RHEA HENDERSON, born on February 26th, 2010 (now aged 8)

7. That the Petitioner's proposals for the upbringing of the children of the marriage are as follows:

That the Petitioner requests Shared Residence Order. That the child do continue to reside primarily with her Father, the Respondent, at #6 Archie Street, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands and that the Petitioner will continue to have shared residence every other weekend from Friday evening until Sunday Afternoon. Plus one month of said child's summer vacation and at such other times as the parties shall agree and arrange between them from time to time. The Petitioner do pay reasonable child support to the Respondent for the child until child ceases full-time secondary education or reaches the age of ~~18~~ 19 whichever is the sooner.

That the Petitioner therefore prays –

- (a) That the marriage solemnized on West Bay, Grand Cayman be dissolved, and
- (b) That the Honorable Court do make such further or ancillary provision including the settlement of marital property and or financial provision and or periodic payments and or damages and or costs as may be just



1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgement of Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and his attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgement of Service must be filed at Court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner, if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgement of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner, if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open court unless an acknowledgement of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands, the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgement of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
