PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE



THE PETITION OF LAURA OLIVIA EBANKS SHOWS:

(1) That on the 18th day of December 2009, in West Bay, Grand Cayman, the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage the marital status of the parties was as follows-

- (i) LAURA OLIVIA EBANKS was a Spinster
- (ii) ORRAIN SHAFIQUE EBANKS was a Bachelor

(2) That following the celebration of the said marriage, the parties lived and cohabitated at 66 Seaside Way, Savannah, Grand Cayman.

(3) That the court has jurisdiction in the above cause by reason that-

- (i) Both, the Petitioner and the Respondent have been domicile in these islands since the date of the marriage and continue to be domiciled in the Cayman Islands.

(4) The said marriage has broken down irretrievably and there is no prospect whatsoever of a reconciliation.

(5) That there are three children of the marriage as defined by law. That the respondent will be responsible for the three said children financially until each attain the age of 18 years of age. That the respondent will have visitation rights to the three said children at his convenience. The petitioner will have full day to day care and custody of the three children of the marriage.

(6) There have been no assets since the time of marriage.

(7) That there is no impediment to this Honorable Court granting a decree of dissolution to the said marriage to the knowledge of the Petitioner.

(8) That there are no previous proceedings brought by the parties hereto in any court with respect of the said marriage.

PARTICULARS OF SEPARATION

(9) The parties of the marriage have lived apart for a continuous period of at least two years immediately preceding the presentation of the petition and the respondent consents to the decree being pronounced.

(10) The marriage has irretrievably broken down and there is no prospect of reconciliation.

(11) The Respondent consents to this Petition.

THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS: -

- 1) That the said marriage be dissolved
- 2) That the Honorable Court makes such orders pursuant to Section 19, 20 and 22 of the Matrimonial Causes Law (1997 Revision) as may be agreed between the parties or otherwise as may be deemed just and equitable by this Honorable Court.
- 3) That there be such further and/or other relief as this Honorable Court may deem just.
