

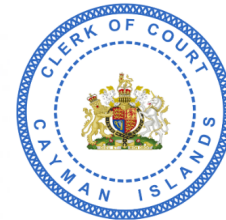

PETITION



The Petition of **COLLIN LINDSAY PEARSON** shows that:

1. On 17 October 1992 at West End, Cayman Brac, Cayman Islands, the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage, the marital status of the parties was as follows:
 - i. The Petitioner was single/never married; and
 - ii. The Respondent was divorced.
2. Following the celebration of the said marriage, the parties have lived and cohabited at the following places in the Cayman Islands: (i) Cotton Tree Bay Road, West End, Cayman Brac; (ii) Bluff Road, West End, Cayman Brac; (iii) Benjamin Wright Apartments, Watler's Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman; (iv) Crystal Rock Apt # 8, Selkirk Drive, Grand Cayman; and (v) Victory Avenue, Prospect, Grand Cayman.
3. The Court has jurisdiction in the above cause by reason that the Petitioner is domiciled in the Cayman Islands.
4. There are no and there have been no previous divorce proceedings brought by the parties hereto in connection with the marriage in any court and there exists no material impediment to this Court granting a decree of dissolution of marriage.
5. The marriage has broken down irretrievably and there is no likelihood of any reconciliation.
6. There are no children of the marriage as defined in the Law.

PARTICULARS OF SEPARATION


- 7. Since the celebration of the marriage, the parties have lived separate and apart for a period in excess of five years.
- 8. In early 2015, the marriage broke down irretrievably and the parties separated at that time.
- 9. The Petitioner left the former matrimonial home in June 2015. The parties have lived separate and apart since that date.

THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:

- 10. That the said marriage be dissolved.
- 11. That ancillary matters be adjourned to Chambers.
- 12. That each party bears their own costs of these Proceedings.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE

IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU, GIVE HIM THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and her attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgment of Service must be filed at court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner, if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in her Acknowledgment of Service that she intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner, if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an “undefended petition” in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open court unless an acknowledgment of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In the case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands, the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgment of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
