NOTICE OF APPEAL

TAKE NOTICE that the Grand Court will be moved so soon as counsel can be heard on the behalf of the above-named Appellant on appeal from the judgement herein of the Immigration Appeals Tribunals given by letter on the 4th March 2020

Whereby it was adjudged

- (i) That the Appellant's appeal against the decision of the Caymanian Status and Permanent Residency Board (CS/PP) Board had been refused.

For an Order

- (ii) The decision of the IAT dated 4th March 2020 be overturned.
- (iii) A declaration that the decision of the IAT in concluding that the CS/PR Board was reasonable in not awarding points to the Appellant under Factor 5 of the Immigration Regulations (2017 Revision) was wrong in law.
- (iv) A declaration that the decision of the IAT in refusing the Appellant's appeal was unreasonable, and contrary to principles of natural justice, therefore constituting an error in law.
- (v) The matter to be remitted to the IAT for re-hearing.



(vi) Any such Order as this Honourable court deems appropriate.
