PETITION FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THE PETITION OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE SHOWS:

- (1) That on the 26th September 2009 at 111 Boltin Ave. In the district of West Bay, the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage the marital status of the parties was as follows:-
 - (a) The Petitioner was Never Married
 - (b) The Respondent was Never Married
- (2) That following the celebration of the said marriage, the parties lived at #34 Jetstar Lane, North Side, Grand Cayman.
- (3) That this Court has Jurisdiction in this cause by reason of the fact that the Petitioner is Caymanian and has been resident in the Cayman Islands since the date of the marriage and continues to be resident in the Cayman Islands.
- (4) That there are no children born into this marriage.
- (5) That there is Matrimonial Property of the Marriage Block 43E Parcel 278 which is located at 21 Frost Street, Bodden Town, in the Cayman Islands, owned 100% by Petitioner and since inception the Respondent has not contributed to the upkeep of the home or made any payments to the mortgage.
- (6) That there is no proceedings pending in this or any other jurisdiction in relation to the said marriage and there is no impediment to this Honorable Court granting a decree of dissolution to the said marriage to the knowledge of the Petitioner.

- (7) Since the celebration of the marriage the respondent has behaved in such a way that the petitioner cannot reasonably be expected to live with him.

PARTICULARS OF UNREASONABLE BEHAVIOUR

- (a) The parties have ceased communicating effectively and their sense of being husband and wife has gone from relationship.
- (b) Communication between the parties is lacking and when there is communication, it is usually demanding, hurtful and/or argumentative which leads to disrespect.
- (c) That the Petitioner has since had a child not for the Respondent.
- (d) That the Respondent has removed himself from the matrimonial home since May 2020.
- (e) Due to the ongoing interpersonal and communication tensions in the relationship, the parties have sought to discuss and resolve their differences, however the Petitioner is of the view that the marriage has broken down as a result of the fundamental irreconcilable differences between the parties.
- (f) The marriage has irretrievably broken down and there is no prospect of reconciliation.
- (g) That there is Matrimonial Property of the Marriage, Block 43E Parcel 278 which is located at 21 Frost Street, Bodden Town, in the Cayman Islands, owned 100% by Petitioner and since inception the Respondent has not contributed to the upkeep of the home or made any payments to the mortgage.
- (h) No Maintenance is being sought after.

PETITIONOR THEREFORE PRAYS:-

- (1) That the said marriage be dissolved.

(2) That the Honorable Court makes such orders pursuant to section 19, 20 and 22 of the Matrimonial Causes Law (1997 Revision) as may be agreed between the parties or otherwise as may be deemed just and equitable by this Honorable Court.

(3) That there is such further and/or other relief as this Honorable Court may deems just.

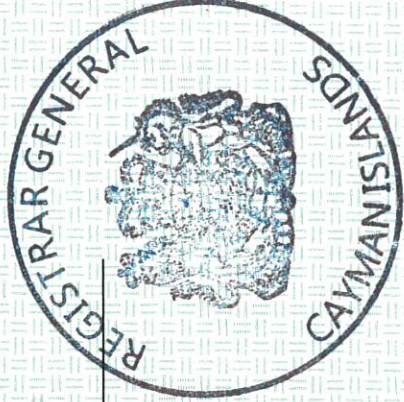
