ORDER

UPON reading the application in writing from Counsel for the Joint Official Liquidators (“JOLs”) of Bear Stearns High-Grade Structured Credit Strategies Master Fund, Ltd (In Official Liquidation) (the “Company”) seeking an order that Jeffrey Stower and Jason Robinson be appointed as JOLs in place of Kristen Beighton and Simon Whicker both formerly of KPMG;

AND UPON READING the Ninth Affidavit of Kristen Beighton sworn on 26 March 2021, the Eleventh Affidavit of Simon Whicker sworn on 29 March 2021, the Affidavit of Jeffrey Stower sworn on 26 March 2021 and the Affidavit of Jason Robinson sworn on 26 March 2021;

IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED that:

1. Pursuant to CWR O.5, r.4:
 - a. Kristen Beighton and Simon Whicker, both formerly of KPMG, SIX, Cricket Square, PO Box 493, Grand Cayman KY1-1106 be released from the performance of any further duties as JOLs of the Company without the need for any report or accounts to be prepared; and

- b. Jeffrey Stower and Jason Robinson of KPMG, SIX, Cricket Square, PO Box 493, Grand Cayman KY1-1106 be appointed as successor JOLs of the Company.
2. All references to the Liquidators or the JOLs in the Order dated 14 September 2007 shall with effect from the date of this order be references to Jeffrey Stower and Jason Robinson.
3. The requirement for publication of notice of the appointment of Jeffrey Stower and Jason Robinson in accordance with CWR O.5, r.3 is dispensed with.
4. The costs of and incidental to this application in relation to the appointment of successor JOLs of the Company shall be borne by the JOLs.
5. This application is suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing.
