ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION by Summons issued on 27 April 2021 by TRANS-CHINA AUTOMOTIVE HOLDINGS LIMITED (the "Company"), the Petitioner named in the Petition presented to this Court in the above matters on 29 April 2021.

AND UPON reading the said Petition and the First Affidavit of Michael Chee Wai Cheung sworn on 26 April 2021.

AND UPON being satisfied that the application may be dealt with administratively

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The Petition be heard before a Judge of the Grand Court on the 23rd day of June 2021 when any creditor or shareholder of the Company who desires to object may attend and be heard;
2. The settlement of a List of Creditors of the Company (section 15(2) Companies Act (2021 Revision)) be dispensed with;
3. Notice of the presentation of the said Petition and of the said day fixed for the

hearing thereof be inserted once in the Cayman Gazette and on two (2) occasions in the Hong Kong Standard newspaper to be run seven days apart, with the notices appearing no later than 14 days before the Petition hearing;

4. By five days before the Petition hearing the Company shall file further materials evidencing compliance with the direction above as to notices.
