APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL

- (a) within six months of the grant to us of probate of the said will, we will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such grant to us we will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the will and the directions, if any, of the courts and file in the Probate Registry a general account accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate in the Cayman Islands.
