PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Defendant is and was at all material times resident in the Cayman Islands. The last known address of the Defendant is 878 West Bay Road, Unit 15 C, Caribbean Plaza, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
2. That on 16 October 2019, the Defendant issued a cheque to the Cayman Islands Government for the payment of work permit fees. The cheque dishonoured by the bank and returned to the Government due to insufficient funds. The details of the dishonoured cheque are:

3. The total sum owed to the Cayman Islands Government is CI\$8,690.00, inclusive of administrative fees.
4. Notwithstanding the demands for full payment being made on the Defendant and efforts to have the Defendant enter a payment agreement, the Defendant has failed to do so.
5. To date the Defendant has failed or neglected to make full payment on this amount despite his promises to do so.
6. As a result of the above, the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief claimed in this proceeding.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- a. CI\$8,690.00 being the total sum due to the Plaintiff.
- b. Fixed costs at CI\$150.00 or as to be assessed.
