ORDER

UPON the humble petition of R&H Restructuring VL Services Ltd (the "**Voluntary Liquidator**") as voluntary liquidator of FELJ Foundation (In Voluntary Liquidation) (the "**Company**") dated 21 July 2021 (the "**Petition**")

AND UPON READING the First Affidavit of Martin Nicholas John Trott sworn 20 July 2021 and Exhibit MNJT-1 thereto

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the Petition is suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The voluntary liquidation of the Company be recalled.
2. The Company be placed into active status and good standing as it was prior to the commencement of the voluntary liquidation.
3. The Voluntary Liquidator be discharged from office.
4. The costs of and incidental to this Petition be paid on the indemnity basis as an expense of the voluntary liquidation of the Company.
