**ORDER**

---

UPON the application of SILVER BASE GROUP HOLDINGS LIMITED (the “Company”) by its Summons dated 11 November 2021 for the appointment of joint provisional liquidators pursuant to section 104(3) of the Companies Act (2021 Revision) (the “JPL Application”)

AND UPON the Order dated 22 November 2021 (the “Order”)

AND UPON reading the Summons dated 29 November 2021, the Fourth Affirmation of Dr. Liang Guoxing and exhibit “LGX-4” (the “Adjournment Application”)

AND UPON hearing from Counsel for the Company on 1 December 2021

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That the JPL Application as referred to at paragraph 1 of the Order, be further adjourned until 10 am on 8 December 2021, with a maximum of three (3) hours allocated for the hearing;
2. All creditors of the Company shall be given written notice of the return date (including the time of the hearing) specified at paragraph 1 above and shall be provided with a copy of this Order of Adjournment forthwith;

3. Any creditors of the Company may file and serve on the Company's Cayman Islands attorneys (Conyers Dill & Pearman LLP) concise written submissions by 10 am on 6 December 2021 which, in particular, indicate whether the creditor supports, opposes or is neutral in relation to the JPL Application; and
4. The Company shall file with the Court, by 10 am on 7 December 2021, a document specifying the names and physical locations of all of the Company's known creditors, as at 7 December 2021, including additional information as to: (i) the total amount of the Company's debt to each creditor; (ii) when any different components of the debt to each creditor will be due or became due; (iii) when each creditor received notice in accordance paragraph 2 of this Order of Adjournment (or confirmation that notice has not been received); and (iv) whether the creditor supports, opposes, is neutral or has not responded to the JPL Application.
