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**ORDER**

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**UPON** the summons dated 22 November 2021 of Jason Robinson and Jeffrey Stower, the joint official liquidators (the “JOLs”) of Kelip-Kelip II Cayman Limited (in Official Liquidation) (the “Company”), for an order for dissolution of the Company and directions:

**AND UPON** reading the Fourth Affidavit of Jason Robinson sworn on 22 November 2021 and the JOLs’ Second and Final Report dated 23 November 2021

**AND UPON** considering that this matter is suitable for disposal on the papers without the need for a hearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The requirement for the JOLs to form a liquidation committee be dispensed with;
2. The Company be dissolved;
3. The JOLs’ liquidation files be preserved for a period of 3 years, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such liquidation files; and
4. The Company’s books and records recovered by the JOLs be preserved by the JOLs for 3 years from the date of the close of liquidation.

5. The requirement to advertise the hearing of the dissolution application be dispensed with.
6. The costs of this application be costs in the liquidation.
