CONSENT ORDER

**UPON** the Order of Segal J dated 2 July 2021 in proceedings FSD 90 of 2021 (the "**Liquidation Proceedings**") appointing Christopher Kennedy and Wing Sze Tiffany Wong as Joint Provisional Liquidators of the Plaintiff (the "**JPLs**")

**AND UPON** the Plaintiff's urgent *ex parte* summons dated 26 July 2021, brought by the Plaintiff acting by its JPLs

**AND UPON** the Order of Segal J dated 27 July 2021 (the "**Injunction Order**")

**AND UPON** the Plaintiff, acting by its JPLs, having issued a Writ of Summons on 30 August 2021 in proceedings FSD 255 of 2021 (the "**Writ Action**")

**AND UPON** the Order of Doyle J dated 14 September 2021 in the Liquidation Proceedings that, *inter alia*, the Plaintiff be wound up and the JPLs be appointed as Joint Official Liquidators ("**JOLs**") of the Plaintiff

**AND UPON** the Plaintiff's application dated 6 December 2021 to discharge the Injunction Order, brought by the Plaintiff acting by its JOLs (the "**Discharge Application**")

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY CONSENT OF THE PARTIES THAT:**

1. The Injunction Order is discharged.
2. The hearing of the Discharge Application listed for 21 January 2021 is vacated.
3. The parties are to submit written submissions (the "**Submissions**") of no more than ten pages by 16 February 2022 on the procedural question of whether the Court should consider and determine the appropriate substantive order as to the costs of the Plaintiff's application for the Injunction Order and/or the Discharge Application (the "**Substantive Costs Arguments**") either: (i) at this stage of the proceedings, or (ii) at the conclusion of the Writ Action.
4. The Court will consider the Submissions on the papers.
5. Liberty to apply.
6. Costs reserved.
