**ORDER**

**UPON** the Winding Up Petition (the "**Petitioner**") dated 12 November 2021 presented by Shine Honour Opportunity VI Limited (the "**Petitioner**") against Puxin Limited (the "**Company**") coming on for hearing

**AND UPON** reading the First Affirmation of Peter Mo Ching Law affirmed on 12 November 2021 and Exhibit PMCL-1 thereto; the First Affidavit of Simon Richard Conway sworn on 11 November 2021 and Exhibit SRC-1 thereto; the First Affirmation of Man Chun So sworn on 12 November 2021 and Exhibit MCS-1 thereto; the First Affidavit of Yat Kit Jong and Exhibit YKJ-1 thereto; the Affidavit of Service of Lucia Mannarino sworn on 19 November 2021 and Exhibit LM-1 thereto; the First Affidavit of Jane Maree Hale sworn on 7 December 2021 and Exhibit JMH-1 thereto; and the Second Affirmation of Peter Mo Ching Law affirmed on 25 January 2022 and Exhibit PMCL-2 thereto

**AND UPON** hearing Counsel for the Petitioner by Zoom videolink at 9am Cayman Islands time on 31 January 2022

**AND UPON** the Petitioner and the Company agreeing to adjourn the hearing of the Petition for three months in order to allow further time for settlement discussions between the Petitioner and the Company

**AND UPON** Counsel for the Petitioner making an oral application for an adjournment of the hearing of the Petition

**AND UPON** no other party appearing at the hearing

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. the hearing of the Petition be adjourned to 9 a.m. Cayman Islands time on 29 April 2022, provided that the Petitioner shall be at liberty to apply by letter to the Court, on not less than seven business days' notice to the Company, for an earlier listing of the hearing;
2. not less than seven business days before the date of the adjourned hearing, the Petitioner shall advertise the hearing of the Petition in the same publications that it advertised the original hearing of the Petition; and
3. costs are reserved.
