IT IS **ORDERED** as follows:


1. The Petition be heard before a Judge of the Grand Court at 9:30a.m. on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022 when any creditor or shareholder of the said Company who desires to object may attend and be heard;
2. The settlement of a List of Creditors of the Company (section 15(2) Companies Act (2022 Revision)) be dispensed with;

Notice of the presentation of the said Petition and of the said day fixed for the hearing thereof be inserted once in the Cayman Gazette and on two (2) occasions in the Standard Hong Kong, to be run seven (7) days apart, with the notices appearing no later than fourteen (14) days before the Petition hearing; and
4. By four (4) days before Petition hearing the Company shall file further materials evidencing compliance with the direction above as to notices.
