
LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Court's Office, P.O. Box 495G George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff c/o Murray & Westerborg, Attorneys-at-Law, 2nd Floor (Southwest Wing) Cayman Shipping Centre Building, 10 Shipping Lane, P.O. Box 10067 Grand Cayman KY1-10067, in his capacity as an Administrator of the Estate of the Deceased, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief against the Defendant:

1. An accounting of all funds held in accounts in the name of the Deceased.
2. An accounting of all funds paid by Sagicor Life Jamaica Limited, being proceeds from Life Insurance Policy in the name of the Deceased, to the Defendant's predecessor in title, the National Building Society of Jamaica, on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 2014.
3. A Declaration as to the outstanding balance due under a mortgage account held by Deceased with the Defendant's said predecessor in title on the 14<sup>th</sup> August 2014 and the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2014.
4. An accounting as to the balance, if any, due to the Estate of the Deceased after the deduction of any mortgage sum deducted from the proceeds of the said Life Insurance Policy as aforesaid.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such Judgment may be given or Order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE  
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

**Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
