**UPON** the application (the “**Application**”) of Graham Robinson of Crowe Cayman Ltd, 94 Solaris Avenue, Camana Bay, Grand Cayman, in his capacity as Official Liquidator (the “**OL**”) of HEC International, Ltd. (in Official Liquidation) (the “**Company**”), made by letter from Campbells LLP dated 20 January 2022 and seeking an order that the requirement to establish a liquidation committee be dispensed with.

**AND UPON** reading the third affidavit of Graham Robinson sworn on 20 January 2022 and exhibit GR-3

**AND UPON** the Court being satisfied that the Application can be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

**IT IS ORDERED that:**

- 1 Pursuant to O.9, r. 1(1) of the Companies Winding-up Rules 2018, the requirement to establish a liquidation committee in respect of the Company be dispensed with.
- 2 The costs of the Application shall be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the official liquidation.
