AMENDED ORDER

UPON CONSIDERING THE APPLICATION by Summons issued on 4 March 2022 of GRAND T G GOLD HOLDINGS LIMITED (the "Company"), the Petitioner named in the Petition presented to this Court on 4 March 2022

AND UPON deciding that an order for directions could be made without the need for a hearing

AND UPON reading the said Petition, the First Affirmation of Dahong Li sworn on 4 March 2022 and the written submissions dated 9 March 2022

IT IS **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Petition be heard before a Judge of the Grand Court at 10am on ~~1~~ 4 April 2022 when any creditor or shareholder of the said Company who desires to object may attend and be heard;
2. The settlement of a List of Creditors of the Company (section 15(2) Companies Act (2022 Revision)) be dispensed with;

3. Notice of the presentation of the said Petition and of the said day fixed for the hearing thereof be inserted once in the Cayman Gazette and on two (2) occasions in the ~~Standard-Hong-Kong~~ **South China Morning Post** in English and a Chinese newspaper in Hong Kong and China, to be run seven (7) days apart, with the notices appearing no later than fourteen (14) days before the Petition hearing;
4. By four (4) days before Petition hearing the Company shall file further materials evidencing compliance with the direction above as to notices; and
5. The Petitioner shall file further evidence as directed by the Judge on 10 March 2022, providing further details with respect to the creditors and liabilities of the Company, within seven days of the date of this order.
