ORDER

UPON the application of Conyers, Dill & Pearman LLP (“Conyers”), as set out in the summons dated 5 May 2022, for a declaration that Conyers may cease to act for Silver Base Group Holdings Limited (the “Company”) in FSD 329 of 2021

AND UPON reading the Affirmation of Norman Hau, together with exhibit “NH-1”, dated 5 May 2022

AND UPON hearing Conyers, as attorneys on record for the Company, on 5 May 2022

IT IS ORDERED, DIRECTED AND DECLARED that:

1. Pursuant to Order 67, rule 6(2) of the Grand Court Rules, the requirement to serve the Company is dispensed with.
2. Pursuant to Order 67, rule 6 of the Grand Court Rules, Conyers may cease to act for the Company in FSD 329 of 2021 (DDJ).

3. Conyers shall serve a sealed copy of this Order on the Company at its Cayman Islands registered office and/or on the Joint Official Liquidators of the Company.
4. The costs of this summons be treated as an expense of the liquidation of the Company.
