APPLICANT: Campbells Nominees Limited in its capacity as trustee of the sole issued share in Winner International Ltd. (the "Applicant")

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2022, at am/pm, on the hearing of an application by the Applicant pursuant to section 48 of the Trusts Act (2021 Revision) (the "**Trusts Act**") and Order 85 of the Grand Court Rules (the "**GCR**") for orders and directions that:

1. the Applicant shall execute the special resolution exhibited in draft p.1 of Exhibit JPW-1 to the First Affidavit John Philipp Wolf sworn on 1 June 2022 (the "**Special Resolution**") placing Winner International Ltd. (the "**Company**") into voluntary liquidation and appointing Campbells Directors Limited ("**CDL**") as the sole voluntary liquidator for the purposes of liquidating the assets and winding up the affairs of the Company in accordance with the Companies Winding Up Rules, 2018 (the "**CRWs**");
2. CDL as voluntary liquidator, and as liquidating trustee under Order 23 of the CWRs, shall take all reasonable steps to contact the ultimate beneficial owner of the issued share in the Company and, failing any claim being made in the course of or following the voluntary liquidation of the Company,

This **ORIGINATING SUMMONS** is issued by Campbells LLP, Attorneys-at-Law for and on behalf of the Applicants, whose address for service is Floor 4 Willow House, Cricket Square, George Town, Grand Cayman (Ref: HTS/12939-01422)

whether by the ultimate beneficial owner of the Company's issued share or by any other valid claimant, CDL shall transfer all undistributed assets of the Company to the Financial Secretary in accordance with Order 23, rule 6 of the CWRs;

3. the Applicant be entitled to payment (out of the assets of the Company) of its properly incurred fees and costs of acting as trustee in accordance with the terms of engagement of Campbells Corporate Services Limited exhibited at pp.2-4 of Exhibit JPW-1 to the First Affidavit John Philipp Wolf sworn on 1 June 2022;
4. CDL is entitled to be paid (out of the assets of the Company) for acting as voluntary liquidator, and as liquidating trustee under Order 23 of the CWRs, in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Special Resolution;
5. the Applicant's costs of and incidental to this application be paid out of the assets held on trust; and
6. such further or other relief as this Honourable Court shall deem appropriate.
