
PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him)

1. On the 26th of October 2021 at about 7:00pm, my parked 2020 Kia Optima, registration number 205 888 was hit outside a residence I was visiting (64 Candover Street)
2. I heard a crash then proceeded to go outside to investigate the noise.
3. Upon exiting the front door, I found that a white Isuzu Elf truck with a trailer attached, carrying heavy machinery, registration number 137546, had crashed into the right hand side of the rear bumper of my car.
4. I then took pictures of the scene and damages and proceeded to call the police to carry out the investigation further and to create a record.
5. The police arrived on the scene 20 minutes later.
6. PC 293 Collymore responded to the accident and PS 204 Belanger ruled, Oshane A Hewitt at fault.
7. The driver of the truck, Oshane A Hewitt, accepted liability for the accident.
8. I, Destinie M Bush and Oshane A Hewitt, had a verbal agreement that he would be responsible for the repairs and proceeded to exchanged details in order to forward with the same.
9. After speaking to the rightful owner of the Isuzu truck, I found out that Oshane A Hewitt, drove the truck without the owner's consent.
10. It has been 6 months of following up and waiting to have my car repaired by Oshane A Hewitt and Mr Hewitt refuses to pay for the damages.
