PETITION

TO: The Grand Court of the Cayman Islands

The petition of Kingfisher Management Limited ("**Kingfisher Management**") and Lawrence Edwards ("**Mr Edwards**") (together with Kingfisher Management, "**Petitioners**"), each of Suite 3-211 Governors Square, 23 Lime Tree Bay Avenue, PO Box 11820, Grand Cayman, KY1-1009, Cayman Islands shows that:


1. Oak Palm Fund Ltd. ("**Company**") was incorporated and registered (registration no. 161809) on 1 February 2006 under the Companies Act (as amended and revised).
2. The last known registered office of the Company was at Suite 3-211 Governors Square, 23 Lime Tree Bay Avenue, Grand Cayman, KY1-1009, Cayman Islands.
3. The last known registered office service provider, namely, one of your Petitioners, Kingfisher Management, resigned effective 3rd December 2020 due to the non-payment of fees.
4. The Company was struck off the register of companies on 30th April 2021.
5. The amount of the reinstatement fee payable upon restoring the Company to the register of companies is CI\$8,670.00.
6. The Company is indebted to your Petitioners in the total sum of at least US\$197,164.59 as follows:
 - a. in the sum of at least US\$129,369.62 to Mr Edwards; and
 - b. in the sum of at least US\$67,794.97 to Kingfisher Management.

7. The indebtedness stated at paragraph 6 above represents the unpaid amounts due and payable in relation to the registered office, corporate services and professional director services provided by your Petitioners to the Company during the period of 2015-2020.
8. The Company is unable to pay its debts.
9. The Company was, at the time of the striking off, carrying on business as an investment holding company. The Company's sole asset at the time of the striking off was a minority shareholding in a company which, itself owned a further company which has an interest in commercial real estate in the province of Ontario, Canada.
10. In the circumstances, it is just and equitable that the Company be restored to the register of companies pursuant to s. 159 and wound up pursuant to ss. 92-94 of the Companies Act (2022 Revision).

The Petitioners therefore pray that:

1. the Company be restored to the register of companies;
2. the Company be wound up by the Court pursuant to the Companies Act (2022 Revision);
3. Karen Scott and Russell Homer of Chris Johnson Associates Ltd., of Elizabethan Square, P.O. Box 2499, 80 Shedden Road, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands KY1-1104, be appointed Joint Official Liquidators of the Company; and
4. such other order or directions be made as the Court thinks fit.
