THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Plaint on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service form stating whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the Acknowledgement of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgement of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for default Judgment without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff was at all material times a resident of the Grand Cayman Island, Cayman Islands and the daughter of the Defendant.
2. The Defendant was at all material times a resident of the Grand Cayman Island, Cayman islands and the biological mother of the Plaintiff.
3. On or about the 14th day of March 2022 the Defendant wrongfully assaulted and beat the Plaintiff by striking here about her body at 6 Manse Road, Bodden Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
4. Further that on or about the 6th day of May 2022 the Defendant wrongfully assaulted the Plaintiff along Manse Road, Grand Cayman by intentionally and purposefully driving her motor vehicle in to the path of the Plaintiff's motor vehicle which was traveling in the opposite direction along the said road, thereby putting the Plaintiff in fear of bodily harm.
5. In a further assault on the Plaintiff on the said day the Defendant attended at the Plaintiff's home along the said Manse Road upon which property she trespassed and as a trespasser assaulted the Plaintiff verbally thereby putting the Plaintiff in fear of physical harm.
6. On the aforesaid date and place the Defendant trespassed onto the Plaintiff's property.
7. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the Plaintiff has suffered both physical and emotional harm.

Particulars of Harm

- (a)** Bruises on the right arm
- (b)** Bruises under her nose
- (c)** Pain


Particulars of Emotional Harm

As a consequence of the said assaults the Plaintiff has had to sleep away from her home in fear of being accosted therein or thereon by the Defendant, her servants and/or agents and is accordingly being deprived of the sanctity, security and enjoyment of her said home.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS

- (a) Damages for physical assault;
- (b) Damages for emotional trauma;
- (c) An Injunction preventing the Plaintiff and/or her agents or servants from trespassing on to her property;
- (d) An injunction barring the Plaintiff, her servants and/or agents from in any way assaulting, molesting, interfering or in any way harassing her as she goes about her lawful business.
- (e) Interest on Damages awarded hereunder at the Statutory rate pursuant to the Judicature Law
- (f) Costs or alternative fixed costs in the sum of \$450.00 plus filing fees.
