ORDER

UPON reading the application of the Joint Official Liquidators (JOLs) of MyTravel 330 Leasing Ltd (in Official Liquidation) (**Company**) made by summons dated 13 July 2022 (the **Application**)

AND UPON reading the Second Affidavit of Elizabeth Galbraith Mackay sworn on 16 September 2022 and accompanying exhibit EM-2

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the Application may be determined on the papers, without an oral hearing

IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED THAT:

1. The remuneration of the JOLs for the period 15 January 2021 to 8 March 2021 when the Company was in voluntary liquidation, and for the period 9 March 2021 to the conclusion of the liquidation, in the total sum of US\$80,000 (in accordance with the fixed fee remuneration agreement entered into between the JOLs and the sole creditor), be approved pursuant to section 109(2) of the of the Companies Act (2022 Revision) (as

Amended) (the **Act**), the Insolvency Practitioners' Regulations (2018) (**Regulations**) and the Companies Winding Up Rules (the **CWR**);

2. The JOLs be relieved of the obligation to establish a liquidation committee as prescribed by Order 9 of the CWR;
3. The Court dispense with the requirement that the JOLs publish an advertisement in respect of the first creditors' meeting pursuant to Order 1 rule 4(1B) of the CWR;
4. The JOLs are granted retrospective sanction for entering into the Distribution Deed dated 29 March 2022 as described in the Second Affidavit of Elizabeth Galbraith Mackay sworn on 16 September 2022;
5. The Company be dissolved pursuant to section 152 of the Act and Order 22 of the CWR;
6. The JOLs be discharged from office and released from any further duties forthwith;
7. The JOLs shall preserve their liquidation files for 5 years from the date hereof, after which the time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such files;
8. The JOLs shall preserve the Company's books and records for at least 5 years from the date hereof, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such books and records;
9. The costs of and incidental to this summons be paid out of the assets of Company as an expense of the liquidation; and
10. This Order for dissolution be filed with the Registrar of Companies within 14 days in compliance with Order 22, rule 2(3) of the CWR.
