
By this Summons, which is issued on the application of **MALAYSIA VENTURE CAPITAL MANAGEMENT BERHAD ("MAVCAP")** the Plaintiff seeks the following orders and directions:

1. Declarations that, pursuant to sections 36(1)(a) and 36(10) of the Exempted Limited Partnership Act (2021 Revision) and the terms of an Amended and Restated Exempted Limited Partnership Agreement dated 25 November 2013 in respect of ECM Straits Fund I, LP (the "**Partnership**") (the "**LP Agreement**"), the Partnership is in voluntary winding up, and that the voluntary winding up is deemed to have commenced on 25 November 2021.
2. An Order under section 36(3)(g) of the Exempted Limited Partnership Act (2021 Revision) that Mr. Michael Penner and Mr. Michael Green of Deloitte & Touche LLP, Citrus Grove Building, PO Box 1781, Grand Cayman KY1-1109, Cayman Islands and Mr. Matthew Becker of Deloitte LLP (Singapore), 6 Shenton Way, OUE Downtown 2, #33-00, Singapore 068809 be appointed as the joint official liquidators of the Partnership (the "**Liquidators**").
3. Orders as to the Liquidators' powers.
4. Such other relief be granted as the Court deems appropriate.
5. An order that the First Defendant pay the Plaintiff's costs of the application.

3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
