APPLICATION FOR RESEALING OF GRANT OF PROBATE UNDER SUCCESSION ACT,
SECTION 23(1)

I, **DAVID JAMES MOIR** of 1602, Quinlan Creek Drive, Kerrville, Texas, United States of America, 78028, the executor named in the Will of Toni Lyn Moir, deceased (the "**Deceased**"), Probate of which was granted to me out of The High Court of Justice of the British Virgin Islands on 28 December 2018 (being the equivalent of a Grant of Probate under the laws of the Cayman Islands and hereinafter referred to as the "**Grant of Probate**"), being over the age of eighteen years and not having renounced probate and the said Grant of Probate, together with the certificate of death, being annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for Resealing of the Grant of Probate of the estate of the said Deceased and enclose my Affidavit in that behalf and undertake that in the event of a Resealed Grant being made to me, I will:

1. within six months of the Resealed Grant prepare a true inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
2. within one year of such Resealed Grant, arrange to have the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands administered according to the directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
