ORDER FOR DIRECTIONS

BY AND WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PARTIES;

AND UPON reading the submissions of the Petitioner and the affidavits in the hearing bundle and the exhibits thereto

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

1. The Petitioner has leave to amend the Petition such that the Amended Petition shall specify the name of Blossom Increase Limited, Leaho Investment Co. Ltd., Modern Rich Investment Limited, Multi Arrow Group Limited, Grace Fine Ltd, and Faith Fame Ltd as the Respondents to the Amended Petition (the "Respondents"), and Tien-Fu Chang shall not be named as a Respondent;

2. The Amended Petition shall be filed by 4pm on 20 January 2023 and shall be served on the Respondents to the Amended Petition by 4pm on 25 January 2023 by the method specified in paragraph 5 below or by service by email upon the Respondents Cayman Attorneys, Harneys and Carey Olsen respectively;
3. The proceedings should be treated as *inter partes* proceedings between the Petitioner and the Respondents;
4. The Company be directed to disclose by 4pm on 20 January 2023 to the Petitioner the register of members of the Company (including all contact details for shareholders used by the Company to call meetings of the Company's members) such information to be used only in relation to these proceedings including in relation to effecting service under paragraph 5 of this Order;
5. The Petitioner may effect service upon members of the Company of this Order for Directions and any further documents required to be served including the Amended Petition, by way of substituted service, by email or registered post using the contact details provided by the Company referred to in paragraph 4 of this Order;
6. The Amended Petition shall stand as the Petitioner's Particulars of Claim;
7. The directions hearing listed for 18 January 2023 shall be adjourned *sine die*. The parties shall seek to agree directions to trial and, if agreement is not reached by 17 February 2023, the directions hearing shall be restored and listed on the first date convenient to the Court and the parties;

Notwithstanding the presentation to the Court on 15th November 2022 of the Petition,
8. no payments made by the Company in the ordinary course of business shall be void pursuant to Section 99 of the Companies Act (2022 Revision) in the event that an order for the winding-up of the Company is made, which for the avoidance of doubt shall include payments by the Company to:
 - 8.1. Its legal advisors in relation to advice given to the Company regarding these proceedings; and
 - 8.2. Its employees in relation to salary payments;

9. Costs of this application to be costs in the cause, save that the Petitioner shall pay the parties' reasonable costs of and occasioned by the amendment of the Petition; and
10. Liberty to apply.




