**ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

---

**LET** the Defendant of 1A Villages, Triton Villas, Boilers Road, Grand Cayman and all person in occupation of property located at Villages #1A Triton Villas, Boilers Road, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, Block 14E and Parcel 661 ("**the Property**") attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on at upon an application by the Plaintiff of P.O. Box 30758, KY1-1204, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, a lessor pursuant to the terms of a Lease dated 1 January 2021 entered into between the Plaintiff and the Defendant ("**the Lease**"), for the following declarations and orders:-

1. That the Plaintiff lessor has the right to forfeit the Lease pursuant to section 55 of the Registered Land Act (2018 Revision)

2. That the Lease was terminated with effect from 22 December 2022
3. That the Plaintiff lessor has the right of re-possession of the Property with the immediate right of re-entry upon the Property.
4. That the Defendant shall deliver up the Property forthwith, or alternatively, the Plaintiff has leave to issue a Writ of Possession pursuant to Order 45, rule 3 of the Grand Court Rules 1995 (As Revised).
5. That Judgment against the Defendant Lessor be entered in the sum of CI\$6,412.23
6. That the Defendant pay the Plaintiff's costs on an indemnity basis pursuant Clause 21 and/or 23 of the Lease.
7. Such further or other relief and directions for sale by private treaty as the court may think just.

**AND LET THE DEFENDANT**, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE  
**OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

**Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
