ORIGINATING SUMMONS


LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Honourable Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands on the
day of 2023 at am/pm upon an application by the Plaintiff, pursuant to the jurisdiction established in *Norwich Pharmacal Co and Others v Customs and Excise Commissioners* [1974] AC 133 for the following orders and directions:

1. The Defendant shall take steps to preserve the documents in relation to WM Motor Holdings Limited, a Cayman registered company, as set out in Schedule A ("**Schedule A**") to the draft Order annexed thereto (the "**Disclosure Documents**").
2. The Defendant shall disclose and deliver to the Plaintiff's attorneys, Conyers Dill & Pearman LLP ("**Conyers**") by a date specified by the Court legible copies of any documents in the Defendant's possession, power, custody or control which correspond to the items listed in Schedule A.

3. The Defendant shall by a date specified by the Court serve on Conyers an affidavit which exhibits the Disclosure Documents, certified by the Defendant as the true, complete, and the most up-to-date copies and sets out to the best of its knowledge, information and belief, the location of the Disclosure Documents.
4. The Disclosure Documents to be produced shall comprise documents in both hard copy and electronic form, and shall include any documents which the Defendant does not maintain at its office within the Cayman Islands but which the Defendant has the power to recall either from elsewhere within the jurisdiction or globally.
5. No order as to costs, save that the Plaintiff shall pay the Defendant's reasonable costs incurred in complying with the terms of this order (any such costs to be assessed on the standard basis if not agreed).
6. Such further or other relief as the Court thinks fit.

LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Summons on it counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Court's office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, KY1-1106

- (1) This Summons may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with that date unless renewed by order of the Court.
- (2) If a defendant does not attend personally or by his attorney at the time and place above-mentioned such order will be made as the Court may think just and expedient.

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1104.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
