PETITION

TO: The Grand Court of the Cayman Islands

The petition of Mr Michael Green and Mr Michael Penner of Deloitte & Touche LLP, Citrus Grove Building, PO Box 1781, Grand Cayman KY1-1109, Cayman Islands and of Mr Matthew Becker of Deloitte LLP (Singapore), 6 Shenton Way, OUE Downtown 2, #33-00, Singapore 068809, each in their capacity as joint official liquidators ("**JOLs**") of ECM Straits Fund I, LP (In Official Liquidation) (the "**Partnership**") shows that:

1. ECM Straits Fund GP I, LP (the "**GP**") is a Cayman Islands exempted limited partnership registered on 6 November 2013 (registration no. 73065) under the Exempted Limited Partnership Act (2021 Revision) (the "**ELP Act**").
2. The last known registered office of the GP was at PO Box 309, Ugland House, KY1-1104, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. The last known registered office service provider of the GP, Maples Corporate Services Limited, resigned in or around September 2021.
4. The GP was struck off the register of exempted limited partnerships on 29 July 2022.

5. The amount of the reinstatement fee payable upon restoring the GP to the register of companies is CI\$8000.00.
6. The GP was, at the time of the striking off, carrying on business as the general partner of the Partnership, an exempted limited partnership registered under the ELP Act (as amended and revised).
7. The general partner of the GP is ECM Straits Fund UGP I, Ltd (the "**UGP**"), a Cayman Islands exempted limited company (which has also been struck off and is the subject of a separate petition by the JOLs).
8. Pursuant to Cayman Islands law, the GP is also liable for the debts of the Partnership. Accordingly, the Partnership is a contingent creditor of the GP for currently unknown amounts.
9. Since their appointment on 24 November 2022, the JOLs have sought information concerning the assets of the Partnership from the directors of the UGP, Mr Abrar Hussain, Mr Arshad Ahmed and Mr Amiruddin Azahar. However, only limited information has been forthcoming and it appears that the UGP and the GP have effectively been abandoned.
10. In the circumstances, it is just and equitable that the GP be restored to the register of companies and wound up pursuant to section 37 of the ELP Act.


The Petitioners therefore pray that:

1. the GP be restored to the register of companies;
2. the GP be wound up pursuant to the ELP Act;
3. Michael Green of Deloitte & Touche LLP, Citrus Grove Building, PO Box 1781, Grand Cayman KY1-1109, Cayman Islands and Matthew Becker of Deloitte LLP (Singapore), 6 Shenton Way, OUE Downtown 2, #33-00, Singapore 068809 be appointed as the joint official liquidators of the GP; and

4. such other order or directions be made as the Court thinks fit.
