Application is hereby made pursuant to Section 4(1) of the Legal Practitioners Act (2022 Revision) to the Honourable Judge of the Grand Court for the limited admission of **BLAIR PATRICIA LEAHY KC**, 20 Essex Street Chambers, 20 Essex Street, London WC2R 3AL, United Kingdom as an Attorney-at-Law of this Honourable Court for the purpose of appearing on behalf of and advising the Official Liquidator (the **“OL”**) of HEC International, Ltd. (in official liquidation) (**“HEC”**) in matter FSD no 318 of 2021 (DDJ) (the **“HEC Proceedings”**), on the grounds that:

1. the HEC Proceedings involve complex and novel issues of law;
2. an application within the HEC Proceedings has been listed to be heard on 23 June 2023 which will have significant consequences for HEC’s liquidation, and at which the OL wishes Ms Leahy to appear on his behalf;
3. there is a large amount at stake in the HEC Proceedings; and

4. HEC is part of a wider corporate group involving other Cayman Islands liquidations in which Ms Leahy has been granted limited admission to appear and advise. Many of the issues and disputes which arise in the HEC Proceedings also arise in and/or overlap with those other liquidations.
