**ORDER**

---

**UPON** the hearing of the Application by Summons dated 5 June 2023 of Christopher Johnson, Official Liquidator of the Company

**AND UPON** reading the First Affidavit of Christopher Johnson sworn on 28 August 2023 and the exhibit CDJ1 thereto

**AND UPON** hearing counsel for the Official Liquidator

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. The Official Liquidator’s fees in respect of the liquidation of the Company and the related liquidation of B & C Capital Ltd (In Official Liquidation):
  - a. for the period from October 1, 2017 to April 30, 2023 in the sum of \$943,495.00;
  - b. for the period from May 1, 2023 to dissolution of the Company and B & C Capital Ltd in the sum not to exceed \$40,000.00 plus a 10% allowance for overagein the total sum of \$983,495.00 plus 10% allowance noted in 1b. be approved;

2. The Company be dissolved pursuant to section 152 of the Act and Order 22 of the Companies Winding-up Rules;
3. The Official Liquidator be discharged from office and released from any further duties forthwith;
4. The Official Liquidator shall preserve the liquidation files for at least 6 years from the end of the year of dissolution of the Company, after which time the Official Liquidator be at liberty to destroy such files;
5. The Official Liquidator shall preserve the Company's books and records for at least 5 years from the date of dissolution of the Company, after which time the Official Liquidator be at liberty to destroy such books and records;
6. The costs of and incidental to this summons be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
