ORDER FOR DISSOLUTION

UPON the application of John Paul Royle and Margot MacInnis in their capacities as joint official liquidators (**JOLs**) of Nutcracker Holdings Limited (in Official Liquidation) (the **Company**) by their Summons dated 1 May 2023 for, *inter alia*, an order that the Company be dissolved (the **Application**)

AND UPON reading the Second Affidavit of John Paul Royle dated 1 May 2023 and its exhibit thereto

AND UPON reading the JOLs' final report and accounts dated 2 February 2023

AND UPON considering the Application suitable to be dealt with administratively on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

AND UPON the Court reading the email from Harneys dated 15 September 2023

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Company be dissolved forthwith from the date of this order pursuant to section 152(1) of the Companies Act (2023 Revision) (the **Companies Act**) and Order 22, rule 1 of the Companies Winding Up Rules (as amended) (the **CWR**).

AND IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that: -

2. The requirement to advertise the hearing of the dissolution application pursuant to Order 22, rule 1(3) of the CWR be dispensed with.
3. The JOLs be discharged from office and released from the performance of any further duties as JOLs of the Company forthwith from the date of this order.
4. The JOLs shall preserve their liquidation files for a period of three (3) years from the date hereof, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such liquidation files.
5. The JOLs shall preserve the Company's books and records for a period of three (3) years from the date hereof, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such books and records.
6. The JOLs' costs of and incidental to the Application shall be an expense of the liquidation.
7. This Order be filed with the Registrar of Companies within 14 days in compliance with section 152(3) of the Companies Act and Order 22, rule 2(3) of the CWR.
