ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION OF David Griffin of FTI Consulting (Cayman) Limited, Suite 3212, 53 Market Street, Camana Bay, Grand Cayman, PO Box 30613, KY1-1203, Cayman Islands and Joshua Taylor of FTI Consulting (Singapore), 8 Shenton Way, #12-02 Axa Tower 068811, Singapore, the joint official liquidators of Yota (In Official Liquidation) (the "**Company**") (the "**JOLs**"), by way of Summons dated 5 October 2023 and subsequent letter dated 5 October 2023 (the "**Application**")

AND UPON reading the Second Affidavit of David Griffin sworn on 5 October 2023 and the exhibit thereto

AND UPON CONSIDERING the Application suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS ORDERED that: -

1. the requirement to form a liquidation committee in accordance with Order 9, rule 1(1) of the Companies Winding Up Rules, 2018 (the "**CWR**") be dispensed with;

2. the requirement to publish a notice of the hearing of this application in one or more newspapers under Order 22, rule 1(3) of the CWR be dispensed with;
3. the Company be dissolved forthwith; and

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that: -

1. the JOLs' liquidation files be preserved by the JOLs for at least three years after the dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such liquidation files;
2. the Company's books and records be preserved by the JOLs for at least three years after the dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs be at liberty to destroy such books and records; and
3. the JOLs file the Dissolution Order with the Registrar of Companies within 14 days of the filing by this Honourable Court of the Dissolution Order
