**ORDER**

**UPON** the Application by Summons dated 5 January 2024 of Karen Scott and Russell Homer (the "JPLs") Joint Provisional Liquidators of Canterbury Securities, Ltd. (in Provisional Liquidation) (the "Company")

**AND UPON** the JPLs having been appointed Joint Official Liquidators ("JOLs") of the Company by Order dated 16 January 2024

**AND UPON** reading the Second Affidavit of Karen Scott sworn on 5 January 2024 and the First Affidavit of Zara Hydes sworn on 11 January 2024

**AND UPON** hearing Counsel for the JOLs and upon hearing Leading Counsel for Ms Erin Winczura

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Erin Winczura do by 2pm on 23 January 2024 (i) attend a meeting with the JOLs and their attorneys to be examined on oath in respect of the Company's affairs; and (ii) provide to the JOLs full information in relation to the Company's affairs including but not limited to those matters set out in an email from Nelsons Attorneys at Law Ltd to McGrath Tonner dated 29 December 2023 which email appears at page 27 of exhibit KS1 to the Second Affidavit of Karen Scott sworn on 5 January 2024. The Petitioner Fortunate Drift Ltd and/or its counsel shall be permitted at the discretion of the JOLs to attend at and participate in the examination.
2. Erin Winczura do within 14 days of the date of this Order pay the JPLs' costs of this application summarily assessed in the sum of US\$9,500.

3. In respect of any document required to be served by the JOLs on Erin Winczura delivery of the same to McGrath Tonner shall constitute good service.
