TAKE NOTICE that the Court at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman will be moved by counsel for The National Conservation Council, on a date to be fixed, for the following relief:

- (1) An order quashing the grant of after-the-fact planning permission and the purported modification of the planning permission (certiorari).

- (2) An order requiring the Second Respondent to decide whether to take enforcement action, in consultation with the Applicant under s.41(3) of the National Conservation Act (mandamus).
- (3) Such further relief as may be needed to give effect to the Court's judgment.
- (4) An order that the costs of and incidental to this application be paid by the Respondents and/or the Interested Party.
