GENERAL INDORSEMENT

---


1. The Plaintiffs are and were at all material times individual proprietors, or assignees of individual proprietors, of the development known as Eleven Parc ("Development") situated on the land at West Bay Beach South, Block 13B, Parcels 234 and 235. The Development comprises 17 townhomes in 5 separate buildings ("Buildings").
2. The Defendant is and was at all material times a Cayman Islands registered resident company with company number 336691, in the business of property development in the Cayman Islands.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of various similar agreements to develop entered into on divers dates as between the Plaintiffs and/or their predecessors in title and assignors, and the Defendant, the Defendant agreed to develop the Development.
4. It has come to the Plaintiffs' attention that there are a number of design and/or construction defects affecting the Buildings including, but not limited to, (i) serious defects with the roofs of the Buildings requiring a full roof replacement; and (ii) certain other structural, external and internal defects.
5. In breach of the express and/or implied terms of the relevant development and/or assignment agreements, the Defendant failed to develop the Development in accordance with the provisions of the development and/or assignment agreements. In breach of the duty of care owed to the Plaintiffs by the Defendant, the Defendant failed to exercise reasonable care and skill in developing the Development.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-

- (1) Damages for breach of contract for the Defendant's failure to develop the Development in accordance with the terms of the relevant development and/or assignment agreements and in a proper and workmanlike manner. Such damages to include the costs of all repairs and remedial work;
- (2) Further and in the alternative, damages resulting from Defendant's breach of its duty of care in failure to exercise reasonable skill and care in developing the Development. Such damages to include the costs of all repairs and remedial work;
- (3) Interest pursuant to Section 39 of the Judicature Act;
- (4) Costs; and
- (5) Such further or other relief as the Court may deem appropriate.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE  
OF WRIT OF SUMMONS

1. The accompanying form of *Acknowledgement of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person.

After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.

2. A Defendant who states in his Acknowledgement of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings *must also serve a defence* on the Attorney for the Plaintiff (or on the Plaintiff if acting in person).

If a Statement of Claim is endorsed on the Writ (i.e. the words "Statement of Claim" appear on the top of page 2). The defence must be served within fourteen (14) days after the time for acknowledging service of the Writ, unless in the meantime a summons for judgment is served on the Defendant.

If the Statement of Claim is not endorsed on the Writ, the defence need not be served until fourteen (14) days after a Statement of Claim has been served on the Defendant.

If the Defendant fails to serve his defence within the appropriate time, the Plaintiff may enter judgment against him without further notice.

3. A *Stay of Execution* against the Defendant's goods may be applied for where the Defendant is unable to pay the money for which any judgment is entered. If a Defendant to an action for a debt or liquidated demand (i.e. a fixed sum) who does not intend to contest the proceedings states, in answer to question 3 in the Acknowledgment of Service, that he intends to apply for a stay, execution will be stayed for fourteen (14) days after his Acknowledgement, but he must, within that time, *issue a Summons* for a stay of execution, supported by an affidavit of his means. The affidavit should state any offer which the Defendant desires to make for payment of the money by installments or otherwise.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of fourteen (14) days for acknowledging service, a Writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.

3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words “sued as (*the name stated on the Writ of Summons*)”.
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an Attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description “Partner in the firm of (.....)” after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description “trading as (.....)” after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorized to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further steps in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL HEALTH PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
