ORDER

UPON the application of Christopher James Smith and Martin Nicholas John Trott of R&H Restructuring (Cayman) Ltd, the Joint Official Liquidators (the "**JOLs**"; formerly the joint voluntary liquidators (the "**JVLs**")) of Atlantis Adventures (Cayman) Ltd (in Official Liquidation) (the "**Company**"), by letter of their counsel dated 16 July 2024 that the Company be dissolved;

AND UPON reading the JOLs' Fifth and Final JOL Report dated 7 June 2024, the Fourth Affidavit of Christopher Smith sworn on 16 July 2024 and exhibit "**CS-4**" thereto;

AND UPON the Court considering the application suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Christopher James Smith and Martin Nicholas John Trott be released from the performance of any further duties as Joint Official Liquidators of the Company.

2. The fees of the JVLs for the period 16 April 2020 to 26 May 2020, as set out in the Fourth affidavit of Christopher James Smith sworn on 16 July 2024, be approved and paid out of the assets of the Company.
3. The fees of the JOLs for the period 27 May 2020 to 31 March 2024, as set out in the Fourth affidavit of Christopher James Smith sworn on 16 July 2024, be approved and paid out of the assets of the Company.
4. The Company be dissolved forthwith pursuant to section 152(1) of the Companies Act (2023 Revision).
5. The costs of and incidental to this Order be paid out the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
6. The JOLs' liquidation files shall be preserved for 3 years after the date of dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs shall be at liberty to destroy such liquidation files.
7. The Company's books and records shall be preserved by the JOLs for 3 years after the date of dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs shall be at liberty to destroy such books and records.
8. The Order be filed with the Registrar of Companies within 14 days of the date of the Order in compliance with Order 22, rule 2(3) of the Companies Winding Up Rules.
