

2. That the Third Defendant shall provide to the Plaintiff's attorneys within three (3) days of producing the documents set out at paragraph 1 hereinabove, a confirmatory affidavit in terms set out at paragraph 1.2 of the Order.
3. That the Defendants' reasonable costs of complying with the Order shall be paid by the Plaintiff, to be assessed if not agreed.
4. An order pursuant to Order 63, Rule 3(4) of the Grand Court Rules (2023 Revision) that pages 483 to 509 of JMK-1 be sealed and not made available for inspection by any person without further order of the Court. Any party applying for such an order shall provide not less than 21 days' notice of the application to the Plaintiff.
5. Such further or other relief as the Court thinks fit.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within fourteen (14) days after service of this summons on them counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to the Defendant.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from the Defendant's own, the form must be completed by the Defendant with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after that Partner's name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN THAT PERSON'S OWN, the form must be completed by the Defendant with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after that Defendant's name.
