Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, KY1-1106, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out full particulars of your defence in the space provided in the Acknowledgment of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgment of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a Default Judgment without any further notice to you.

**PARTICULARS OF CLAIM**

1. The Plaintiff is a law firm registered in the Cayman Islands and licensed in accordance with the provisions of the Legal Practitioners Act (2022 Revision). The Plaintiff, through its partners and associates, supplies legal services within the jurisdiction of the Cayman Islands.
2. The Defendant is an individual, normally resident in Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. On 21 April 2023, the Defendant instructed the Plaintiff to provide legal services.
4. Between 21 April 2023 and 22 September 2023, the Plaintiff provided legal services upon the defendant's instructions.
5. The Plaintiff submitted the following invoices to the Defendant, identifying the payments due from the Defendant.

6. The Defendant was contractually required to pay each invoice within 14 days of receipt.
7. The Defendant shall be given credit for payments made in the sum of \$1,500.00.
8. Despite the Plaintiff contacting the Defendant to request payment on multiple occasions, the amounts due from the Defendant to the Plaintiff have not been paid.
9. Accordingly, the Plaintiff claims liquidated damages in the amount of CI\$3,281.25 in respect of the Unpaid Invoices, together with pre-and post-judgment interest on those damages in accordance with s.34 of the *Judicature Act (2021 Revision)* and the *Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 2012* at the statutory rate of 2.375%, from 14 October 2023. Interest accrued to 19 March 2025 is claimed in the sum of CI\$129.29, continuing to accrue at the rate of CI\$0.247 per diem.

**AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:**

- (1) Liquidated damages in the sum of CI\$3,281.25;
- (2) Pre- and post-judgment interest on those damages in accordance with s.34 of the *Judicature Act (2021 Revision)* and the *Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 2012* at the statutory rate of 2.375%, from 14 October 2023. Interest accrued to 19 March 2025 is claimed in the sum of CI\$129.29, continuing to accrue at the rate of CI\$0.247 per diem.
- (3) Fixed Costs; alternatively, costs to be assessed.
