THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the Acknowledgement of Services form.

IF YOU FAIL to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a **default judgment** without further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff is a 72-year-old male a retiree who was, at all material times, employed as an Education Coordinator/Senior Residential Worker at CAYS Foundation.
2. The Defendant operated a mechanic and auto body repair shop named Wise Auto, at all material times.
3. The Plaintiff and the Defendant were acquaintances during the relevant period. The Plaintiff would bring students (that were residence at CAYS) at the Defendant's business at Wise Auto Red Gate Road for internship opportunities.
4. Through their professional interactions, the parties developed a friendship over many years.
5. The Plaintiff informed the Defendant that he was approaching retirement and wished to establish a tyre sales and repairs business. The parties discussed the business venture. The Defendant researched the tyre options and provided the Plaintiff with a quotation for the cost of the tyres. Based on this, the Plaintiff issued a manager's cheque to the Defendant.
6. On September 6, 2016, the Plaintiff gave the Defendant a mangers cheque in the amount of US\$15,358.16 for the purchase of the tyres.
7. The Defendant failed to deliver the tyres, therefore both parties having several discussions about the issue and agreed that the money will be refunded. The Defendant had made many promises to return the money but he has not done so.
8. Since 2019, the Plaintiff has repeatedly requested a refund from the Defendant, but to date, the Defendant has failed or refused to comply.
9. The Plaintiff and the Defendant have exchanged numerous WhatsApp messages regarding the refund, but the Defendant remains non-compliant.
10. On February 20, 2025, an attempt was made to serve the Defendant with a letter "Final Notice to Pay" but the Defendant deny knowing the Plaintiff.

- (a) The sum of US\$15,358.16 which is equivalent to CI\$12,910.85
- (b) Interest at the statutory rate.
- (c) Such further and other relief that the Court deems fit.
- (d) Cost.

If within the time for returning Acknowledgement of Service the Defendant pays to the Plaintiff Attorneys-at-Law the total amount of claimed of \$15,358.16 all further proceedings will be stayed.
