THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out below.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, Po Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, KY1-1106, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. By promissory note (the 'Note'), dated 15 April 2021, the Defendant acknowledged that she was indebted to the Plaintiff (then known as Surefine Fund, Ltd) ('Surefine') in the total sum of CA\$ 4,830,000 in a repayment of a loan granted to her by Surefine.
2. Amongst other things, the Note provided that the Defendant would:
 - a. Pay to Surefine the sum of CA\$ 690,000 100 days from the date of the advance of the loan granted by Surefine.
 - b. Pay to Surefine CA\$ 4,140,000 3 years from the date of the advance of the loan granted by Surefine (the 'Debt').
 - c. Pay interest at 2% per month on any overdue payments due under the Note.
3. While the Plaintiff made payment of CA\$ 690,000 pursuant to the terms of the Note, the Debt fell due on 15 April 2024 and remains outstanding.
4. The Defendant has acknowledged that she is obliged to pay the Debt.

AND the Plaintiff Claims:

1. An order that the Defendant pay the Plaintiff the sum of CA\$ 4,140,000.
2. In the alternative, damages for breach of contract.
3. Interest in accordance with the Note, in any event, in the current sum as of April 23, 2025 of CA\$ 85,414.60 and accumulating at the rate of 2% per month until the Debt is paid.
4. In the alternative, interest pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Act (2021 Revision) at such rate and for such period as the Court finds fit.
5. Costs.
6. Such further and / or other relied as the Court finds fit.
