Box 6, Grand Cayman KY1-1101, Cayman Islands, British West Indies, hereby apply for a Grant of Letters of Administration De Bonis Non of the estate of the late, Joseph Burkley McLean aka Joseph Berkley McLean (the “**Deceased**”), formerly of East End, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, British West Indies, who died on, or about the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 1956, intestate, and to whose estate on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 2021, in Cause P & A No. 22 of 1982, a Grant of Letters of Administration De Bonis Non of all of the estate which by law devolves on and vests in the personal representative of the said intestate Deceased were committed and granted to JOSEPH BERKLEY McLEAN, previously of P.O. Box 6, Grand Cayman KY1-1101, Cayman Islands, British West Indies, lawful son of the intestate Deceased, which Grant now remains on record, and who, after intermeddling in the estate and effects, died on, or about the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January 2025, leaving part of the estate un-administered.

And I declare myself bound unto the Financial Secretary of the Cayman Islands in the sum of C\$100,000.00.




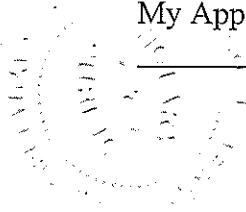
