

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff paid the sum of CI\$4,000.00 to the Defendant on or about December 2024 as the purchase price for a motor vehicle described as a Kia Rio (the "Vehicle").
2. The said sum was paid in full and in good faith on the understanding that the Vehicle was roadworthy and suitable for lawful use on public roads in the Cayman Islands.
3. At the time of the sale, the Defendant was aware that the Vehicle had a fault with its airbag system, evidenced by an illuminated warning light, but failed to disclose this material defect to the Plaintiff prior to the sale.
4. Upon attempting to license the Vehicle with the relevant authorities, the Plaintiff was informed that the Vehicle could not be licensed due to the said airbag fault, rendering it unfit for legal use on the road.
5. The Defendant has failed to deliver a Vehicle that is in a condition capable of being properly licensed and lawfully driven, which constitutes a fundamental breach of contract.
6. The Plaintiff has requested a refund of the purchase price in the amount of CI\$4,000.00, but the Defendant has refused or neglected to repay the said sum, claiming that the funds have already been spent and that he is unable to make repayment unless the Vehicle is sold to another party.
7. The Plaintiff therefore claims the return of the sum of CI\$4,000.00 as money paid for no consideration, or alternatively, as damages for breach of contract.
8. On or about April 2025, the Plaintiff made a formal report to the Royal Cayman Islands Police and attached to this plaint is a copy of the police report.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

- 1 The sum of CI\$4,000.
- 2 Interest in the sum of \$0.00 calculated at the prescribed rate from to date.
- 3 Fixed costs of ~~\$0.00~~, alternatively costs to be assessed.
